A) The following articles or property will not be accepted for shipment nor as a premium when accompanying other articles:

- Bank bills
- Evidences of debt or deeds
- Letters of credit
- Letter and packets of letters with or without postage stamps
- Passports
- Bullion, coin or currency
- Notes, drafts or securities
- Postage stamps
- Valuable papers of any kind
- Jewelry, other than costume or novelty jewelry
- Precious stones or metals which are not a direct part of industrial or data
- Museum exhibits, original works of art, articles of antiquity
- Live animals
- Human remains
- Plants (not dormant)
- Vehicles, used, not self-propelled, such as passenger, house or sleeper trailer cards, carts or coaches
- Firearms and rifles (assembled or in parts), and ammunition (in Western Canada only) – will only be handled from a) wholesaler to wholesaler or b) manufacturer to wholesaler or to retailer
- PCB's (Polychlorinated Biphenyls)
- Poison infectious substances
- Explosives, 1.4D, 1.4G and 1.4S are acceptable in restricted quantities. Not accepted if moving to USA.
- Explosives requiring placards are acceptable subject to prior approval by the Safety Department. Pre-alerts including a scan of the DG documents must be sent to CLC, re-ship Service Centres, CF Safety Department and destination Service Centres. Not accepted if moving to USA.
- All shipments tendered to carrier with improper, inadequate or insufficient packaging – unless zero value declared and owner's risk of liability
- All shipments containing articles which because of their build, length, width or height cannot, in the carrier's judgment, be safely stowed within a trailer or container
- All shipments which contain, on whole or part, articles prohibited by law
- All shipments which contain, in carrier's judgment, are of unusual or extraordinary value – customers can call the CF Business Centre to receive a quote for a third party insurance quote
- Freight with a propensity to damage other freight or carrier's equipment
- Hazardous Waste in quantities that require a Waste Manifest and Hazardous Waste Transport License – check the Safety Department document links on the intranet.

B) The following additional articles will NOT be accepted for shipment from points named in this tariff to points situated within the United States of America:

- Automobiles, used
- Cryogenic liquid, flammable or non-flammable, in DOT 4L cylinders or portable tanks
- Explosives, in any quantity
- Perishable, frozen or other commodities requiring protection by heat or refrigeration, in LTL lots
- Plants (not dormant)
- Vehicles, used, not self-propelled, such as passenger, house or sleeper trailer cards, carts or coaches
- Radioactive material

CF Group of Companies assumes no liability for any prohibited or restricted articles that are inadvertently received and subsequently damaged during transportation.

In the event that CF Group of Companies unknowingly accepts cargo names above due to shipper incorrect description of prohibited or restricted articles, CF Group of Companies shall hold the shipper(s) solely responsible and liable for any penalties and/or damages resulting from transportation of the restricted cargo.

Any declared value amount will be considered null and void.

The Acceptance for carriage by CF Group of Companies of any high-risk commodity shipment bearing a declared value will not constitute a waiver of this provision.
