

CROSS BORDER SECURITY

For transportation of shipments into Canada, CF Group of Companies is:

- *CSA approved: As a CSA carrier, CF Group of Companies can help CSA approved customers achieve the benefit of streamlined clearance across the border.*
- *PIP approved: As a PIP member, CF Group of Companies is part of a program that promotes a working relationship between the trade community and the transportation industry to prevent illegal trade.*
- *FAST approved into Canada: The FAST program is a joint Canadian-U.S. initiative supporting the movement of pre-approved eligible goods across the border, with faster processing and fewer inspections. Our participation in the FAST program means CF Group of Companies is able to provide faster, more reliable service across the border.*

For transportation into the U.S., CF Group of Companies is:

- *C-TPAT certified: C-TPAT is a joint government-business initiative designed to improve security and streamline the movement of shipments across the border.*
- *FAST approved into the U.S.: The FAST program, as explained above, is a joint Canadian and U.S. initiative that offers approved members expedited clearance for eligible goods. As an approved carrier, CF Group of Companies is entitled to use the FAST lanes at U.S./Canada border crossings instead of the standard commercial lanes.*

If you ship goods across the Canada-U.S. border, the CSA & C-TPAT certification programs may help you streamline your cross-border shipments. If your company is CSA or C-TPAT approved, by partnering with CF Group of Companies and taking advantage of our approved status, you can:
